


Install and Configuration Manual

The first 2 steps will require Admin privileges so be sure to have the proper access and click yes when windows ask for privileges confirmation.

1- Download and execute the installer

 Lanetalk.Brunswick.Synchronizer.exe

2 -The Brunswick Settings application should open automatically, otherwise execute the link that appears on the desktop.

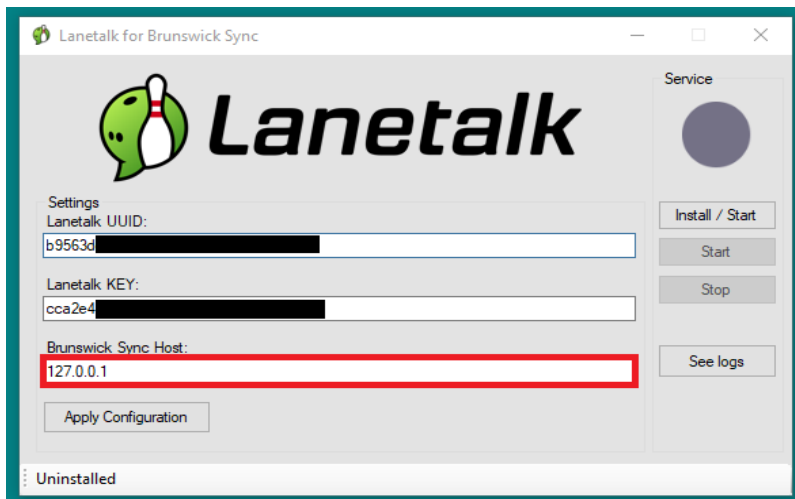
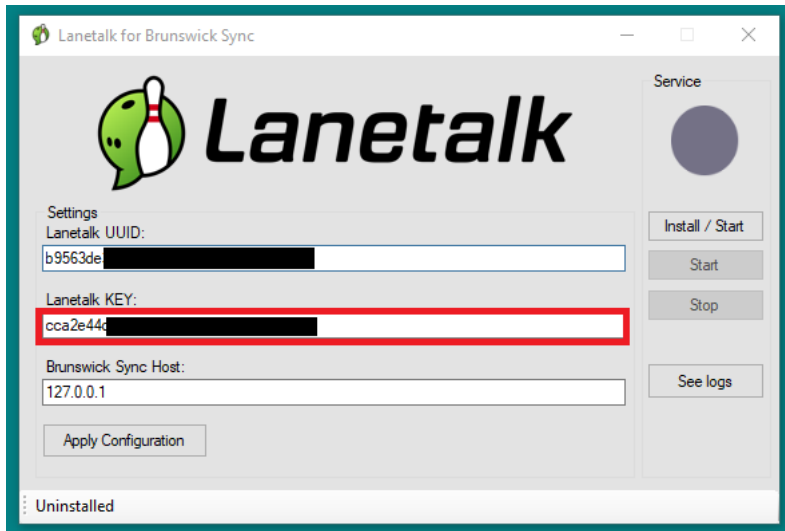
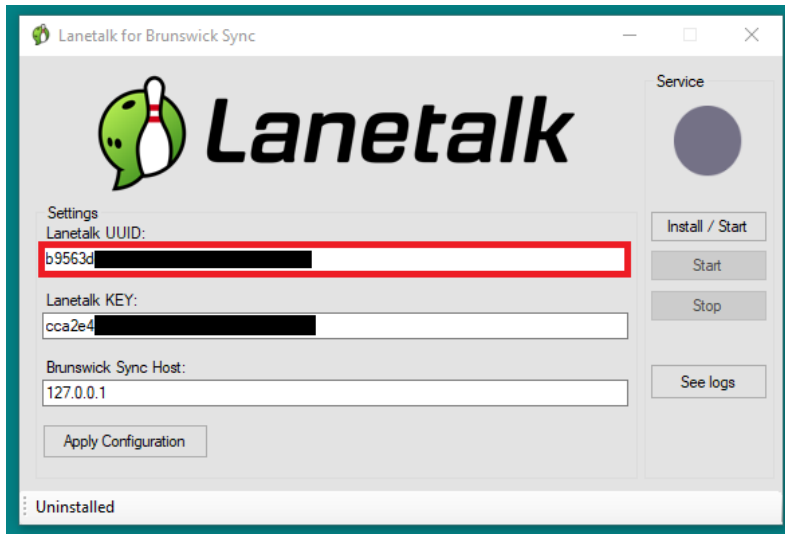


3 - Once opened you must enter:

Lanetalk UUID: Identifier of your Bowling Alley on Lanetalk.

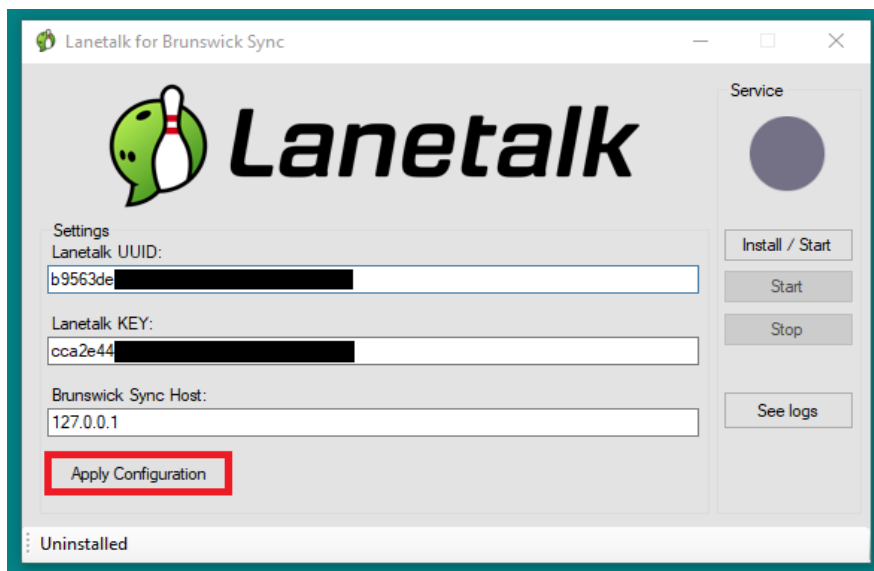
Lanetalk Key: Api Key to be able to send your data to the system.

Brunswick Sync Host: Host of the Brunswick Synchronizer.



4 – After setting all the values you must apply configuration.

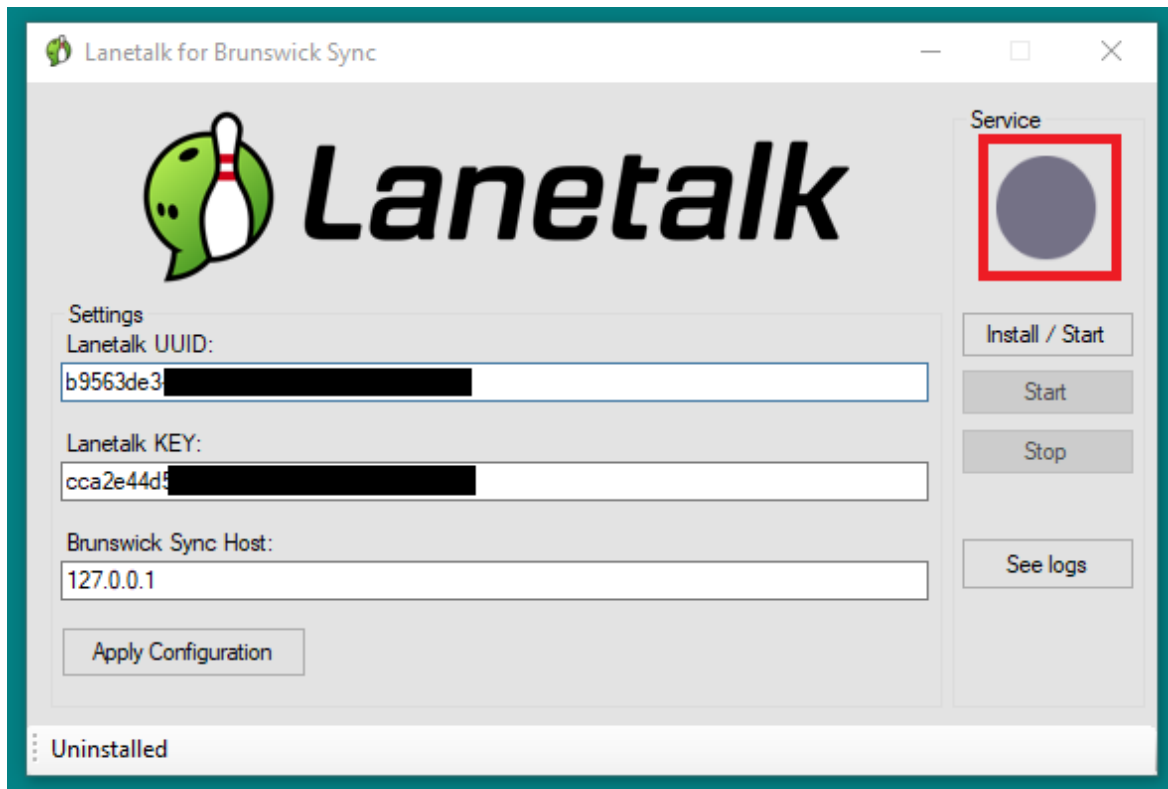
Remember to apply configuration every time you make a change on any of these values.



5 - Once applied the configuration. You must Install/Start the service by clicking on the button with the same name.

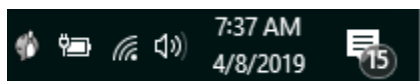
At the right of the window you can see the Service Panel which has firstly an indicator of the current state of the service (you can see it too on the status bar and on the tray bar).

Gray means uninstalled. Green means running and red means installed but stopped.



You can either close the application or minimize it to tray where you have an icon that changes according to the state of the service.

From there you can either stop/start the service or re-open this windows by clicking configuration.



If you want to check the state of the service in a detailed way you can always hit the see logs button which will take you to the logs folder.
